A simple allergy solution—just a few drops under the tongue.

Tired of relying on pills, inhalers or nasal sprays? No time for allergy shots at the doctor's office? Now you may find fast, lasting relief with under-the-tongue allergy drops that can be taken in the comfort of home.

How do oral drops work?

Oral drops are a type of *immunotherapy*. Immunotherapy is the only treatment proven to alter the underlying allergic disease instead of just its symptoms. Other treatments such as pills provide only short-term relief. When patients stop taking them, the symptoms return.

Immunotherapy starts with a serum that can be delivered through shots or, more conveniently, through under-the-tongue drops. The serum contains extracts of common allergens found in nature (pollens, pet dander, etc.) In time, the serum can desensitize the body to allergens so that it stops overreacting to the environment in ways that lead to troubling symptoms.

Oral drops contain all-natural antigens and have been shown to be safe—even for children.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Does the program work well for children?

Because oral drops are pain-free, they are well-suited for children, and studies have shown them to be safe—even for children under 5 years of age.¹

Is oral drop therapy (also known as sublingual immunotherapy) scientifically proven?

Dozens of studies verify the safety and efficacy of sublingual immunotherapy (SLIT). For example, The Cochrane Collaboration (internationally recognized as the highest standard in evidence-based health care) reviewed 22 studies involving 979 patients using SLIT and concluded that SLIT is a safe treatment which reduces symptoms and medication requirements in allergic rhinitis.²

SLIT is widely used in Europe where it accounts for at least 45 percent of allergy treatment.³ SLIT is affirmed by the World Health Organization and the ARIA guidelines (Allergic Rhinitis and its Impact on Asthma). In addition, our studies show that more than 80 percent of allergic patients and 90 percent of asthmatics report marked symptom relief within the first few months of using **AllergyEasy** drops.

What does the serum taste like?

The liquid has a slightly sweet, medicinal taste (some patients have compared it to Chloraseptic) but not enough to be bothersome. Most patients, even children, are unfazed by the taste.

Are there any risks or side effects?

Oral allergy drops contain the same all-natural antigens found in shots. However, because drops are not associated with the same degree of risk for anaphylactic reaction that shots are, they are safe enough to be taken at home.⁴

When was sublingual immunotherapy developed?

SLIT was developed more than 80 years ago. It is widely used throughout the world and is especially popular in Europe where it accounts for more than 45 percent of allergy treatment.

How long does it take to see results?

The majority of **AllergyEasy** patients experience marked symptom relief within the first few months of starting treatment. Many patients see improvement in as little as a few weeks.

Will insurance cover the cost of the serum?

Many insurance plans cover the cost of allergy testing and associated physical examinations/office visits. Fewer insurance companies cover the sublingual drops; however, many patients find that it can be cheaper to pay cash for allergy drops than to pay the actual co-pays for allergy shots. Less trips to the doctor's office can be an added time and money saver.

I'm going on vacation. Can I take the serum with me?

Yes! **AllergyEasy** drops are ideal for frequent travelers. The serum's portability and self-administration allow patients to maintain desensitization while on the road. And for patients traveling by air, our dropper bottle is less than 3 ounces in compliance with current TSA regulations.

I'm moving. Will the serum still protect me in a new place with different allergy sources?

AllergyEasy drops are extremely comprehensive and designed to protect patients from most common allergens from around the world. So whether you are in Arizona or New York, Dublin or Sydney, you can expect extensive allergy protection.

How do the oral drops work?

With shots, allergy serum is injected into the bloodstream. With oral drops, the serum is placed under the tongue where it can be easily absorbed into the bloodstream.

What are **AllergyEasy** drops made of?

They are made of common antigens found in nature (the things you breathe in on a daily basis) in a liquid saline solution.

Do allergy drops work for food allergies?

As a general rule, we recommend staying on the serum for at least 3 years. After this, some patients are able to stop taking the drops without relapse. Others stay on a basic maintenance dose to stay allergy-free.
